Concepts of Carbon Trading

Kenya's Climate Change Amendment Act, enacted in 2023, introduced comprehensive measures to regulate carbon markets and trading. Subsequently, the Climate Change (Carbon Market) Regulations 2024 came into force on 17th May 2024 via legal notice No. 84, effecting the Climate Change (Amendment) Act, 2023. Kenya's carbon trading efforts are crucial for reducing emissions by 32% by 2030. However, many stakeholders are unfamiliar with carbon trading concepts, hindering their participation in policy processes and global markets. The training is an opportunity for conservation stakeholders to gain insights into the principles, dynamics, and best practices of carbon market trading.
